What is this product?

Type

Creand Global Investment SICAV-SIF - Hanway A (EUR) Cap is a Public Limited Company (*société anonyme*) organized under the laws of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg and having the status of a specialized investment fund under Part II of the SIF Law (13 February 2007).

Term

The Fund has no maturity date. Notwithstanding this provision, the Fund may be dissolved at any time by a resolution taken by the general meeting of shareholders.

Objectives

The Sub-Fund aims for long-term capital appreciation through a diverse portfolio, including equity and fixed-income securities, financial derivatives, and money market instruments. The Investment Manager follows a macro approach, analyzing global economy, interest rates, and inflation impacts to select promising sectors and companies. Geographical and sector restrictions do not apply. Borrowed capital usage is capped at 25% of NAV. While no Sustainability Risk Integration Policy currently exists, work is ongoing for ESG integration. Investments' sustainability risks may affect asset value. ESG ratings are for information only. Investment Advisor: HANWAY CAPITAL S.L. (not regulated by CNMV). The Fund's investments don't align with EU sustainability criteria.

Intended investor

The Sub-Fund is limited to Eligible Investors: Well-Informed Investors and non-Prohibited Investors. Prospective investors must provide required information, documents, and affidavits to demonstrate eligibility. Well-Informed Investors include institutional, professional investors, or those investing at least EUR 125,000, supported by relevant assessments. Directors and managers fall under this category. The Fund may refuse Shares, rights, or redeem Shares held by Prohibited Persons as defined by the Offering Memorandum, seeking indemnification except in cases like inheritance.

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Risk Indicator



The Recommended Holding Period of the product is 5 years.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because the Fund is not able to pay you. We have classified this Fund as 3 out of 7, which is a medium risk class. This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium-high level, and poor market conditions will likely impact the Fund's capacity to pay you. You may lose up to the totality of the amount you have invested in the Fund. What are the costs?

We have assumed:

- In the seventh year you would get back the amount that you invested minus the total costs (233.2 (\$)), which has an annual cost impact of 2.33%.

How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

The product is recommended to be held for 5 years. Redemptions can be made on each Valuation Day. The Valuation Day occurs on the 15th and last day of each month, or the preceding Business Day if necessary. Shareholders with redeemable Shares can request redemption on a Redemption Day, receiving the Net Asset Value as of that day. The redemption price is paid to the registered Shareholder. Redemption Forms must be submitted before the Cut-Off Time. The Fund doesn't cover delays or charges by receiving banks. Cut-Off Times for orders and payments for redemption are 2 Luxembourg Business Days after the Valuation Day.
